### Carter County School Closure Feeding Site Information

**March 18-31, 2020**

The Carter County School Nutrition Department is offering drive-thru feeding sites at five schools within the school district area beginning March 18, 2020. We will have 5 sites providing a grab and go lunch to any child between the ages of 0-18. The meals will be given to children at no cost, regardless of income. Each site will have a feeding station set up outside of the school's cafeteria in the parking lot. Parents/guardians may drive to the feeding site where staff can hand a meal to each child in the vehicle. **Children must be present to receive a meal. Lunch will be served Noon-1:00PM, Monday-Friday.** Schools will not be open to the public, only approved Carter County School System staff members will be allowed inside the buildings.
